Interpreter Skills Online Training for NAATI Credentials

This course meets the training requirements set by NAATI (National Accreditation Authority for Translators and Interpreters) for anyone wishing to sit for Interpreter test or apply for Recognised Practising Interpreter.

This course will include live (synchronous) sessions as well as online moderated forums and language specific tutorials.

Pre-requisites
