Course cost

Training is supported through the Tasmanian Government's *Training and Work Pathway Program 2022*. The training cost subsidised at \$250.00 for program participants. There will be additional costs associated with any intrastate travel and accommodation related to completion of the program. If you are employed, your employer may be willing to assist with subsidised cost.

Eligibility

This training and development program is open to 25 participants. To be eligible for this program, participants must:

- Be from culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD), Non-English speaking, refugee or migrant background.
- Be an emerging leader that can demonstrate motivation and aspiration to develop leadership knowledge and skills
- Be committed to complete the program by attending all four workshops, networking events, mentorship sessions and project work.

What to bring

Emerging leaders should be prepared with standard items such as a pen, notebook or paper.

You may wish to bring your own laptop or electronic device to assist with the training.

Outcome

On successful completion of the program, they will receive a Statement of Attainment for the following units:
